YOUR 2025 MIPS READINESS GUIDE

Ensure the financial success of your practice by avoiding a negative 9% payment adjustment on your Medicare reimbursement! To set your practice up for success, follow our 2025 MIPS Action Plan for a potential positive 9% payment adjustment!

1. Determine Eligibility Status

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- Verify your clinician eligibility at <u>https://qpp.cms.gov/participation-lookup</u>
 - Set-up a QPP account and connect to your practice here <u>https://qpp.cms.gov/login</u>
- Make note if you have clinicians who are part of an APM and have different reporting requirements
 - NEW in 2025 APM participants may no longer be exempt from reporting and have specific requirements to meet
- Determine if you are required to report or if you can opt-in to the program
 Decide whether you will report as an individual (by NPI) or as a group (by Tax ID)

2.Set Practice Goals

Do you want to avoid a negative payment adjustment?

- There is no longer a COVID-19 hardship available and switching EHRs or Tax IDs will not qualify for a hardship
- Are you looking to earn a positive adjustment?
 - Scoring over 75 points under MIPS will earn you a positive payment adjustment

3. Understand the Financial Impact

- Identify your annual Medicare Part B reimbursement amount and calculate what a -9% penalty would cost you in lost revenue
- Understand what a potential +9% incentive could earn you in additional reimbursement
- Determine the ROI on working with a MIPS expert like DAS!



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4. Create an Action Plan

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- Identify which staff will be responsible for your MIPS reporting
- Review and select measures for:
 - Quality (based on 2025 benchmarks released by CMS)
 - Promoting Interoperability (required measures & review exclusions you may qualify for!)
 - Improvement Activities (NEW requirements in 2025 only report the minimum necessary)
- Understand how the Cost Category impacts your score by reviewing previous performance and scores in your QPP portal
- Create an audit folder to maintain documentation for a MIPS data validation audit (DVA)

5. Understand New Program Requirements & Regulations

- Make sure you are using Certified EHR Technology (new requirements in 2025 & 2026)
- Evaluate other regulations that impact or overlap with MIPS
 - State PDMP and eCR requirements, Information Blocking rules, ASC CAHPS requirements, etc.
